Multi-talented performer/director and vocal coachSal Dupree served as a special casting director for the film. One of the film's producers, Diane Kirman, a long time friend and colleague of Sal's, is a Philadelphia native who works out of both L.A. and South Jersey. Finally one of the Robinson kids is played by **Blake Bashoff**, who was raised in Northeast Philly with summer home ties to Ventnor. Dupree is also a well known singing and acting coach, and Blake is one of his students.

A legendary singer and per-former, Sal Dupree is owner of the Dupree Performing Arts Studio in Linwood, one of the largest vocal/performing arts schools in South Jersey. Although he grew up in Brooklyn and South Philly, he's lived in South Jersey for over 25 years.

Sal is also a voice teacher and performing arts coach. His students have appeared on Broadway, TV and in feature films. In his spare time, he continues to direct and produce musicals, raising money for various charities. He also does feature film casting including Mannequin and Rocky V.

Sal told old pal Kirman about Blake. "Sal has an incredible eye for talent," explained Kirman. "I've cast a lot of kids in films who have been trained by Sal and have
